



RIVERLINK BUILDING WORKS IN PROGRESS

Construction of The Riverlink Building is a key part of the second component of The Levee Development. Works scheduled for May and June 2017 includes:

- Erection of structural steel elements, including columns and roof beams
- Commencement of brick walls construction
- Construction of stone pavement on the Riverside Walk.

The majority of the structural steel will be erected from within the site (396 to 400 High Street), however a number of large 16 metre long roof beams will need to be delivered and craned in from High Street. This will require a daytime road closure (for vehicular traffic only) of High Street between Bulwer and Elgin Streets on Monday 8 May 2017.



WORKS ON BOURKE STREET LINK AND RIVERSIDE WALK

Upgrades to the Bourke Street Link and part of the Riverside Walk are major parts of the second component of The Levee Development. Work in these areas is expected to commence in May 2017, with completion planned for late 2017.

Construction work on the Bourke Street Link and Riverside Walk includes:

- Reconfiguring the pedestrian ramp and stairways
- Repairing the retaining wall directly behind the Bourke St Link
- Laying stone pavement
- Installation of public space furniture including bench seats and table, chair and umbrella sets
- Planting trees to provide shade in the Bourke St Link.

WORKS ON HIGH STREET (EAST AND WEST)

Included as part of the works on The Levee Development Component Two are upgrades to High Street (East) from Bourke Street to Preschool Lane and High Street (West) from Elgin Street to Church Street. Work in these areas is expected to commence, following completion of design plans, in the third quarter of this year, with completion planned for late 2017.

The upgrade works will include drainage modifications, replacement of footpaths with concrete, replacement of kerb and gutters, and asphalt resurfacing of the road pavement.
